State Senator Brad Hawkins (R)

Representative Hawkins grew up in the Wenatchee Valley and received his K-12 education in the Wenatchee School District.

He was elected to the House of Representatives in 2012 and to the State Senate in 2016. Prior to being elected to the Legislature, Brad served for 10 years on local school boards, including two years as board president.

He serves on the Early Learning & K-12 Education (Ranking Member), Higher Education & Workforce Development, and Transportation Committees.



State Representative Keith Goehner (R - position 1)

Representative Goehner comes to the Legislature with an extensive background in local government. He served four terms as a Chelan County Commissioner.
