State Senator Drew Hansen (D)

Senator Drew Hansen has focused on opening up opportunities for people in Kitsap County to get trained for good jobs that support their families. His work to build partnerships with Olympic College, Western Washington University, and apprenticeship programs has transformed lives across the district. He also sponsored Washington's landmark free college tuition law and the nation's first state-level net neutrality law, New Hope Act, the DREAM Act 2.0, and the Public Broadband Act.
