
MEET YOUR LEGISLATORS

State Senator Claire Wilson (D)

Senator Wilson Claire identifies as a lesbian woman and is one of seven LGBTO lawmakers in the Washington State Legislature. She has been a strong proponent of reform in the juvenile justice, child welfare, corrections systems and has championed an act to make childcare and early learning more affordable for Washington families. She has volunteered for and served on numerous organizations and boards including the PTA. Citizens for Federal Way Schools, the Advisory Board of the Washington Family Engagement Trust, the Mentor and Me Program, and many more.

She holds the role of Assistant Majority Whip. Her committees include Human Services (Chair), Early Learning & K-12 (Vice Chair), Transportation and Rules.





State Representative Jamila Taylor (D - position 1)

Representative Taylor worked as the central area network coordinator for the Seattle Youth Violence Prevention Initiative, where she oversaw community interventions and supported young people facing family, peer or gang conflict; court involvement; school suspension or expulsion; homelessness; and other risk factors for youth violence. She later worked as a statewide advocacy counsel for Northwest Justice Project.

She chairs the Legislative Black Caucus and is vice chair of the Majority Caucus. Her committees includes Housing (Vice Chair), Human Services & Veterans Committee, Community & Economic Development and Transportation.





State Representative Kristine Reeves (D - position 2)

Representative Reeves is the current Director of Economic Development for the Military and Defense sector for the state of Washington. Her role focuses on securing federal grants and promoting public and private economic development that supports military bases; defense industry suppliers, contractors and small businesses, as well as working with community advocacy support organizations in their engagement with the U.S. Military in WA State. She was also the Statewide Veterans Constituency Coordinator for U.S. Senator Patty Murray.

Her committees include Agriculture and Natural Resources (Vice Chair), Consumer Protection & Business (Vice Chair), and Regulated Substances & Gaming.
