

Senator Keiser was the former chair and longtime member of the Senate Health & Long-Term Care Committee. She was the leader in reforming WA's State health care system, fully implementing the Affordable Care Act, and passing WA's State Paid Family and Medical Leave program. She also served as the lead Senate Democratic negotiator on the Capital Budget.

Representative Orwall has 20 years of experience working in the public mental health system, expertise in strategic planning in workforce development and affordable housing. Her legislative accomplishments include Rape kit reform, creating a trauma-informed response for survivors, suicide prevention (8 bills ranging from training requirements, K-12, higher education, and Safer Homes), antitrafficking, the Foreclosure Fairness Act, compensation for those wrongly convicted, adoptee rights and more.

Regulated Substances & Gaming,
and Rules.











State Representative Mia Gregerson (D - position 2)

Representative Gregerson served on the SeaTac City Council from 2008 to 2015. Her legislative accomplishments include expanding voting rights, ensuring our residents are housed, helping to establish Washington's first Office of Equity, championing statewide digital equity, and being part of the so-called "food fighters" who work together on legislation to help the food insecure. She previously worked as a surgical assistant and business manager in the dental field for nearly twenty years.

She serves as chair of the House Members of Color Caucus (MOCC). Her committees include Appropriations (Vice Chair), Rules and State Government & Tribal Relations.
