#### State Senator Andy Billing (D)

In the Senate, Senator Billing continues to be an advocate for children, working families, and small businesses, putting people first in Spokane and throughout the state. He has been particularly active as a legislative leader on early learning and K-12 education. Prior to joining the Senate, Andy represented Spokane in the state House of Representatives. As vice chair of the House Transportation Committee, he helped craft the state's bipartisan 2012 transportation budget that created more than 43,000 jobs across Washington.

He serves on the Rules, and Ways and Means Committees.





## State Representative Marcus Riccelli (D - position 1)

Born and raised in Spokane, Representative Riccelli is deeply committed to fostering opportunities for young people in Spokane. He serves as an advisory board member for the Northside YMCA and coaches youth sports.

He passed multiple bills expanding access to free school meals, benefiting hundreds of thousands of Washington students.

He serves as chair of the Health Care & Wellness, Appropriations, and Local Government Committees. He also serves on the Joint Legislative Executive Committee on Planning for Aging and Disability Issues and the Universal Health Care Commission.



## State Representative Timm Ormsby (D - position 2)

Timm has served on a number of committees during his tenure in Olympia and for several years was vice chair of the House Capital Budget Committee, developing the state's construction budget. He is a special appointee to the State Investment Board and the Select Committee on Pension Policy, which he chaired in 2013-14, and is also a special appointee to the Washington State Investment Board.

Timm serves as chair of the House Appropriations Committee – the panel charged with writing the House version of the state's biennial operating budget. He's also a member of the House Labor and Workplace Standards Committee.
