
MEET YOUR LEGISLATORS

State Senator Matt Boehnke (R)

Sen. Matt Boehnke is serving his first term representing the 8th Legislative District in the State Senate, after serving two terms in the Washington House of Representatives.

In the House, Matt served on three committees, the Community and Economic Development Committee (ranking minority member), Appropriations, and Environment and Energy committees.

Matt currently serves on the Senate Human Services (Ranking); Business, Financial Services, Gaming & Trade; Environment, Energy & Technology; and Ways & Means Committees.
